## Guest Speaker for May



#### Nick Adams

Nick Adams is a four-time best selling author, motivational speaker, Fox News commentator, business innovator and Stage IV cancer survivor. He was a Presidential appointee in the Trump Administration. He runs the Foundation for Liberty and American Greatness (FLAG), a non-profit organization that teaches civics and informs parents and students on the power of the American Dream.

His work in public schools has seen him recognized by governors across the country, and he has been awarded honorary status in Texas, Kentucky, Oklahoma, Arkansas and South Carolina.

Nick was born and raised in Australia,. He is an immigrant to America, receiving a rare Extraordinary Ability Green Card.

Adams earned both undergraduate and postgraduate degrees at the University of Sydney. He was publicly elected the youngest Deputy Mayor in Australian history in Sydney, at the age of twenty-one.

## Legislative Report from the Texas House Legislative Session 87 (R)

In this 87th Texas Legislature Session there have been <u>5,734</u> House Bills (HB) filed! In the Senate there have been <u>2,629</u> Senate Bill (SB) filed!

These bills were introduced by Mayes Middleton

<u>House Bill 3046</u> Introduced by Mayes Middleton and joint authored by Burrow & Metcalf. Coauthors are Bonnen and Leman. Identification of and prohibited cooperation with certain unconstitutional acts of federal government in other words to prohibit cooperation by the state of Texas and all local entities with certain federal acts that violate the United States Constitution.

<u>HB 1568</u> Introduced by Mays Middleton and joint authored by Buckley, Keith Bell, Krause. Bill is aimed at controlling appraisal growth and saving school districts money on correcting appraised values. It has advanced from the Texas House Committee on Public Education.

Bills to be brought before Committee:

- <u>HB 803</u> requires a presumption of 50/50 shared possession by parents who are parties to a child custody dispute following a divorce.
- <u>HB 3028</u> prohibits insurance companies from discriminating against business or customer who choose not to receive the COVID vaccine through increased premiums or other costs.
