Dr. Pat McGinnis

He began his career as a flight surgeon for NASA and the US Air Force Reserve, and then embarked into the emerging discipline of Healthcare IT. He is also an Adjunct Professor at the UTHealth School of Biomedical Informatics, one of the premier institutions of the Texas Medical Center. He currently serves on the Friendswood Downtown

Economic Development Corporation and the Galveston County United Board of Health.

Dr. McGinnis' entry into the political arena began in 2002. In 2008, he attended his first precinct convention, and subsequently has been a steady presence within the Galveston County Republican Party activities. He has attended every Senate District and RPT State Convention since then. In 2012, he was an alternate delegate to the Republican National Convention. He was elected and served two terms on the City Council of Friendswood TX. He served as the Program Chair, and then President of the Galveston County Republican Network. He was elected to be the Chairman of the Galveston County Republican Party in 2020.

As most of you know more than 50 House Democrats left the state of Texas to avoid passing the Texas Election Integrity bill, and to support federalizing election Law. This cowardly action not only stopped that bill, but every other bill on Governor Abbott's agenda for the special session.

While the House Democrats were away the Senate has held a quorum and has been busy passing every bill on the agenda. This includes:

SB1 Election Integrity

SB2 Fair Sports for Women and Girls

SB3 Banning Critical Race Theory in our schools

SB4 Banning Social Media Censorship

SB5 Stopping Social Media Censorship

SB6 Bail Reform

SB7 13th Check for Retired Teachers

SB8 and 12 Property Tax Reform

SB72 Increasing Family Violence Prevention

Unfortunately, these bills will go nowhere unless the House gets back to work and passes them. Governor Abbot has promised to call additional Special Sessions until this work gets done.

Campaign Activities Report: Kathie Nenninger explained how to count volunteer hours and stated the logs on each table could be used to report hours.


Events: Event chair Kristen Day discussed the upcoming training to register voters May 13th. She also announced the June mixer information is on the website.
