Invocation: Mary Blackwell

Pledges: Led by County Commissioner Darrell Apffel

Welcome and Introductions: President Roxann Lewis introduced elected officials, candidates and guests.

Membership: Barbara Meeks reported the club has 119 full members and 58 associate members.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes were approved as circulated by newsletter.

Treasurers Report: Melissa Johnson stated our total balance from Texan bank is \$12,726.79

Announcements: Roxann Lewis shared her experience at National convention receiving the Diamond award for CCRW. Glynis Chester, TFRW President, won the Reagan Leadership award. Republican women have volunteered enough hours that monetarily would be worth \$300 million.
