PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Welcome Back from Summer Break!!

It was a banner year for SCOTUS rulings. Finally, after years of work and prayers, SCOTUS has ruled on states' decision on Pro Life issues. This is a major victory and Republican women have been on the front lines in this battle for years. In addition, they ruled in favor of our Second Amendment rights, rolled back the EPA's ability to reduce the carbon output of existing power plants, blocked the Biden Administration's vaccine or testing requirements for the nation's largest employers (but stopped short of protecting health care workers in facilities that receive Medicare and Medicaid funding), ruled states cannot bar religious schools from receiving public grants that are extended to other private schools, and finally they ruled that the right of public prayer at school events was a right guaranteed in our Constitution as free speech and religious exercise. These are just a few highlights of the court's rulings.



Thank you to all who attended our RPT State Convention and were involved in setting the state platform for the next 2 years.

We are gearing up for block walking and phone calling to support our local candidates. Please stay tuned for details on how you can get involved in these local activities.

United Against Human Trafficking—Sara Jayne Breuer August 5th

Sarah will provide an overview on human trafficking, which includes the data and statistics, profiles of traffickers and their recruitment tactics, red flags and what you can do if you suspect someone is being trafficked, or additional actions to help fight human trafficking!

We believe that no human life should be for sale. Children, teens, and adults of all genders are exploited for sex and labor in our city every day. We exist to change that.

Preventing Exploitation

To fully end human trafficking, we must both support survivors and prevent people from ever being abused. By learning how to recognize the signs of trafficking, teens know how to stay safe and avoid exploitation. Informed kids are less likely to succumb to traffickers' tactics.

Educating the Community

Education prepares the community. Through educational trainings, we prepare professionals, first responders, and community members to recognize and address human trafficking situations. Institutions become qualified to aid victims and survivors with a trauma-informed approach. Through our podcast, community members learn how to break down the systems that enable trafficking to flourish.

Empowering Survivors

Outreach prevents exploitation and empowers victims and survivors. Through case management, support groups, and direct outreach, we bridge the gap between service providers and those who need them. We interact with overlooked people to identify exploitation and empower them with appropriate resources for restoration.

Human trafficking is a violation of basic human rights and should be addressed as such. Together, we must restore that basic human right to every trafficked person—freedom.

Legislative Report—August 2022

Get out the vote:

1. Voting
2. Tell 10 others to register to vote.

It's been a **HOT** summer! Not just in terms of the weather, but in terms of news from the Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS). They made rulings based on our constitution instead of making rulings based on emotions or liberal fads.

The **HOTTEST** news is that SCOTUS ruled to overturn Roe v. Wade on June 24, 2022, giving rights back to each state to decide on abortion laws. Texas, along with thirteen other states, will ban abortions except under limited exceptions. Individuals violating this act will be charged with a first-degree felony, along with other civil penalties.

Our second **HEAT** wave, no pun intended, is a ruling in regard to our Second Amendment rights. SCOTUS ruled that Americans, *law-abiding Americans*, have the constitutional right to carry handguns outside of their homes for self-defense. While this ruling does not impact Texas' current laws to carry handguns openly without a license, this ruling will assist with any future restrictions on the Second Amendment.

The **HEATWAVE** continued with the SCOTUS ruling in favor of a high school football coach. It is now OK for the Washington State High School football coach to pray on the field after a football game. The Supreme Court voted 6-3 in favor of prayer. Americans, Texans, let's all begin a **storm** of PRAYER.

WOW! NEW CHANGES TO VOLUNTEER HOURS

YOU CAN NOW COUNT and COUNT and COUNT MORE! [Enter hours here.](#)

The National Federation of Republican Women has developed new and exciting guidelines for determining your political volunteer hours to be more inclusive as to what we really do politically.

New Categories and Changes for Reporting Hours and what to include:

***NEW CATEGORY* ... CALLING**

- ◆ Include all calls for any political activities, such as initiatives or ballot questions.
- ◆ Dialing apps will record the number of calls you have made, or you can use your best estimate.

POLITICAL HOURS

- ◆ Travel time to and from the activity.
- ◆ Research and development of the activity... Do you write letters to the editor, text or share posts on FaceBook about meetings, political activities? Include your time spent connecting with others.
- ◆ Preparation and breakdown of activity. Hours collected are on a best estimate basis.
- ◆ Round up to the closest whole hour.
- ◆ Primary and Associate member hours are included.
- ◆ ***New*** All volunteer political activities, whether **paid or unpaid** (Example: **paid election worker or poll watcher**) are eligible!
- ◆ ***New*** **State Representatives and State Senators may submit their hours too as this is not their main source of income.**
- ◆ Exception...Individuals who are salaried campaign and/or GOP professional staff do not qualify (i.e., those who earn their living by being employed in politics).

EXAMPLES OF ACTIVITIES

- ◆ All time spent at Club, Region, State, and National Federation meetings or conventions (**in person or virtual**).
- ◆ All campaign activities benefiting the Federation, the Republican Party, or Republican candidates.
- ◆ ***New*** Attendance at all Republican events, including Lincoln Day Dinners, **even if tickets were purchased for attendance.**
- ◆ Running for Office (partisan or non-partisan) as a Republican Candidate.
- ◆ Walking precincts, preparing letters to the editor or elected officials, any phone calls, radio, TV and social media appearances, **posting to social media**, voter registration, writing or editing a digital or hardcopy club newsletter, attendance at rallies
- ◆ Working on any aspect of a Republican campaign (partisan or non-partisan)
- ◆ Working on Republican ballot questions, initiatives, or petitions
- ◆ Serving as an elected member of your Local, County, State or National Party Committee, ie: Precinct Chairman, GCGOP Committee
- ◆ Attending, preparing for, or volunteering at Club, Region, State, and National Federation meetings or conventions
- ◆ ***New*** **Attending**, preparing for, or volunteering at meetings or conventions of the Local, County, State, and National Republican Party or **local meetings to include CCRW** or conventions to include our Clear Creek Republican Women meetings
- ◆ Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican office
- ◆ Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican candidate, or elected official's office
- ◆ **Working as an Election Officer, Poll Watcher, Challenger, or Election Integrity worker even if paid!**
- ◆ Organizing or teaching a Campaign Management School
- ◆ All campaign activities benefiting our Republican Party, candidates, and/or the Federation
- ◆ Time spent making political and campaign calls
- ◆ Any other political or campaign activities

2022 Texas GOP Convention

June 16 -18, 2022

These priorities were chosen by over 5,000 voting delegates at the state convention, June 13-18, 2022 in Houston, Texas. Delegates were presented with a [list of 15 topics selected by the Legislative Priorities Committee](#) after a comprehensive review of resolutions passed at the precinct and senate district levels of the convention process. Delegates were allowed to vote on 8 topics, which became the official Legislative Priorities of the Republican Party of Texas.

1. Protect our Elections:

Restore felony penalties and enact civil penalties for Election Code violations, which shall be enforceable by any Texas jurisdiction, including the Texas Attorney General. Require citizenship verification of each voter. Restrict the distribution of mail-in ballots to only disabled, military, and citizens that are out of state. Reduce the time allowed for early voting, and eliminate the three-day gap between early voting and election day. Establish closed primaries in Texas. As technology evolves, we encourage the passage of legislation that ensures the security of our elections.

2. Secure the Border and Protect Texans:

Texas shall immediately deny all taxpayer funded services and subsidies to illegal aliens. We call upon the Governor to assert his duty under Article 1, Section 10, Clause 3 of the US Constitution to declare an invasion on our Texas border and do everything in his power to protect Texans from this invasion. The legislature shall direct the Governor to enter into an Interstate Compact with one or more states for Border Security.

3. Ban Gender Modification of Children:

Texas must ban chemical castration, puberty blockers, cross-sex hormones, genital mutilation, bodily alteration surgery, psychological/social transitioning, and any other methods applied to or performed on children.

4. Stop Sexualizing Texas Kids:

Repeal Texas Penal Code "Obscenity Exemption" 43.24(c), which allows children access to harmful, explicit, or pornographic materials and 43.25(f)(2 3), which allows sexual performance by a child. In addition, prohibit teaching, exposure, and/or discussion of sexual matters (mechanics, feelings, orientation, or "gender identity" issues), and prohibit use or provision of related books and other materials using criminal, civil or other enforcement measures.

5. Ban Democrat Chairs:

To ensure all legislative Republican priorities are given a fair opportunity to become law, the Republican-controlled Texas legislature shall adopt a rule that would end the practice of awarding committee chairmanships to Democrats.

6. Abolish Abortion in Texas:

Abolish abortion by ensuring the right to life and equal protection of the laws to all preborn children from the moment of fertilization, including adopting effective tools to ensure the enforcement of our laws to protect life when district attorneys fail to do so.

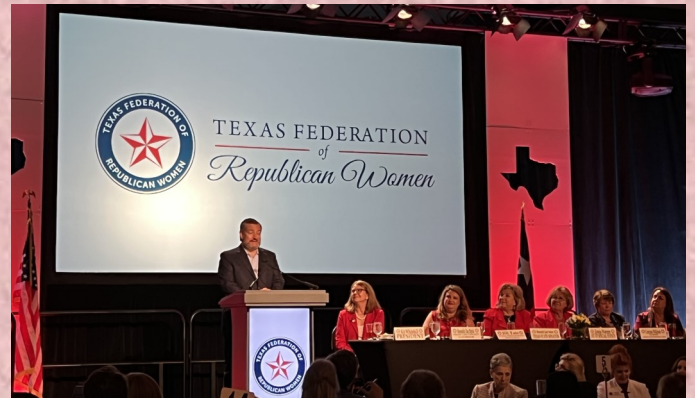
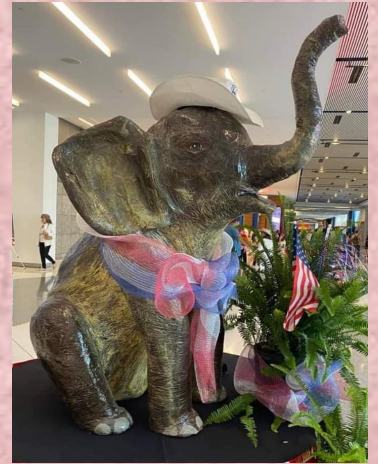
7. Defend Our Gun Rights:

Protect our gun rights against threats, such as red flag laws, federal, state or other restrictions, by strengthening and preserving our inalienable rights under the second amendment to protect our life, liberty and property. The Texas Legislature should eliminate gun-free zones.

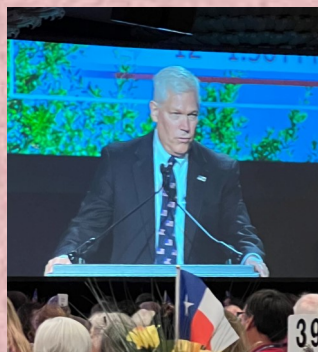
8. Parental Rights and Educational Freedom:

Parents are the primary decision makers for their children in all matters. This authority shall be protected as an inalienable right. This shall include the choice of schooling where the money follows the child without strings attached, and enforcement and penalty mechanisms when parents' rights are violated. The right to education shall be free from any social theories.
